OPPORTUNITY

Students admitted to and enrolled in Bristol Community College’s Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) program have the opportunity to complete their studies at Bristol while also maintaining “Provisional Admission” status with Emmanuel College’s Bachelor of Science in Nursing program (RN-BSN). Students are guaranteed admission if they successfully graduate with all required courses at Bristol and have a valid nursing license in good standing.

STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

- Successful completion of the Bristol Community College Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) degree as evidenced by an official Bristol transcript reflecting the conferred ASN Degree.
- Matriculation in Emmanuel College’s RN-BSN program within two years of completing the ASN at Bristol. (After such time the joint admission opportunity will expire and students interested in the RN-BSN degree at Emmanuel will need to pursue a new application for admission to the College.)
- Current and valid Massachusetts RN license.

STUDENT BENEFITS
