

## General Education Equivalency Guide

The BCC Transfer Office has negotiated a number of general education course equivalency guides with area colleges. The guides list the general education courses that all students are required to take at the 4-year colleges and the BCC courses that are equivalent.

### UMASS Dartmouth

*The courses listed below meet the University's general education requirements. Students in each college of the University (Arts & Sciences, Business, Engineering, Nursing, and Visual and Performing Arts) must also meet distribution requirements specific to that college.*

*Courses that fulfill distribution requirements may also meet general education requirements. For example, a student seeking a Bachelor of Arts degree in the College of Arts & Sciences must fulfill 6 credits of literature and 12 credits of foreign language. By fulfilling these distribution requirements students also fulfill the University Cultural and Artistic Literacy requirement. Please see UMASS Dartmouth's 2004/2006 catalog for more information.*
