Calling all students with an entrepreneurial mindset! Bristol Community College is now offering a Weekend Fast Track program that allows students to earn a business degree in just 12 months. Weekend Fast Track includes an entire degree into one compressed course design.

The program, offered at the BCC Fall River, New Bedford, and Attleboro Campuses, will begin June 2017 and will meet on both Saturdays and Sundays. Courses in the program will operate as a hybrid combination of online and classroom format.

Students who successfully complete the 12-month weekend program will earn their Business Administration associate degree allowing them to use their skills immediately or transfer their credits to many four-year colleges and universities.
