GLOSSARY

- **Equivalent:** A course that contains the exact same content and credit hours as the BCC course listed, e.g. PSYC 205 @ MCC ≠ PSY 252 @ BCC but BIOL 1010 @ CCRI = BIO 233 @ BCC. **NOTE:** Students who have completed coursework at regionally accredited institutions using a quarter hour system will have their credits converted to BCC's semester hour system to determine credit hour equivalency.
- **Higher Level:** A course that is at a higher level than the listed pre-admission requirement within the same subject area, e.g. PSY 252: Child Development is a *higher level* course than PSY 101: General Psychology.
- **Regional Accreditation:** A college or university accredited by one of the regional agencies listed at <https://ope.ed.gov/accreditation/agencies.aspx>.
