This agreement is designed to facilitate the educational mobility and transfer of students from Bristol to Bryant with eligibility requirements and benefits indicated below.

- Guaranteed admission with 3.0 or better and full-time status
- Merit based scholarships ranging from \$14,000 - \$20,000 (renewable)
- PTK member scholarships - \$2,500 additional
- \$50 application fee waived

Bryant University reserves the right to rescind the offer of admission based on information provided on the student's application.

Bristol and Bryant agree to communicate any curriculum changes and policies which affect the agreed upon relationship. Both parties reserve the right to amend or revise by mutual consent and in writing, this agreement, or to change curriculum whenever feasible.

Bristol and Bryant will review this agreement each year and will notify the other party, in writing, if they want to terminate the agreement.

Bristol and Bryant will continue to develop pathways for students in other associate degree programs that deem suitable for transfer.
