In order to reduce the cost of continuing educational opportunities among its Registered Nurses, **Bristol Community College (“Bristol”)** enters into an agreement with **Salve Regina University (“Salve Regina”)** and its partner, iDesignEDU, LLC (“iDesign”).

Salve Regina is committed to creating the most cost-effective and flexible nursing degree programs in the region while delivering the highest quality nursing education backed by CCNE accreditation. Salve Regina proudly offers a suite of in-demand nursing programs to help any of your nurses reach their educational goals.

With this agreement, Salve Regina will offer a preferred tuition rate to nurses from Bristol who are admitted to one of the online nursing programs. The preferred tuition rate will also be extended to family members of Bristol employees who hold a valid nursing license and are admitted to one of the online nursing programs at Salve Regina. The preferred tuition rate is subject to change.

For the most up-to-date pricing, please visit onlinenursing.salve.edu. This partnership underscores Bristol’s commitment to the professional growth and development of its nursing staff and is a benefit to all employees.

Bristol will take no part in the application or admissions process of the online nursing programs, which will solely be the domain of Salve Regina. Additionally, Bristol will not be party to the financial or academic relationship between an admitted or enrolled student and Salve Regina, regardless of whether that person is a Bristol nurse or family member of a Bristol employee. The agreement does NOT act as a formal clinical affiliation agreement between Bristol and Salve Regina, which will be signed separately. This agreement simply extends the opportunity for a preferred tuition rate to Bristol nurses or family members of employees.

To facilitate access to, and interest in, Salve Regina’s online nursing programs, Bristol agrees to designate a staff member to act as program coordinator to communicate this new partnership internally to staff members via email and in-person announcements. In addition, this program coordinator will help facilitate quarterly in-person or digital interactions, where Salve Regina representatives can meet prospective students face-to-face to share information and answer questions.


Upon confirmation of internal communication of the program and partnership, nurses and family members of Bristol employees will have access to the preferred tuition rates listed below. The term of this agreement shall be for one (1) year and shall automatically renew for successive periods of one (1) year, until terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon sixty (60) days prior written notice. Termination of this agreement will not affect the admission status of currently enrolled students.




