EMPATH MOBILITY MENTORING

- Our program partners with EMPath Mobility Mentoring® as we apply its Bridge to Self-Sufficiency® model.
- The Recruitment Counselor, along with campus and community resources, works one-on-one with students to address personal plans that include managing course work, resolving debt, meeting basic needs, and connecting to wellness resources.

PROFESSIONAL MENTORING

- Students are paired with a mentor who can relate to the challenges of being a Bristol student parent.
- Mentors share professional and personal experiences; promote and establish relationships with students; and have experience in working with underrepresented populations.



MONTHLY SUPPORT CIRCLES

- An empowering, safe, and inclusive space for parenting students to build and foster community by sharing experiences and stories

PROGRAM WORKSHOPS

- BayCoast Bank: Income & expenses, and one-on-one consultations
- Time Management
- Internship opportunities and professional development
- Managing tantrums: Coping mechanisms & effective communication for toddler, child, and adolescent behavior

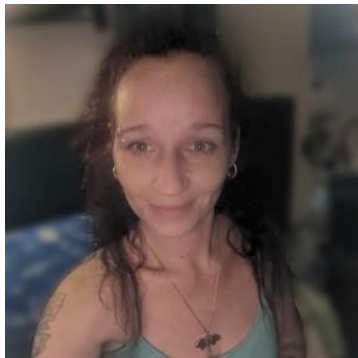
