

## Student Right-To-Know

The Bristol Community College 150% of normal time to completion graduation rate for First-time Full-time certificate and degree-seeking students entering the college in Fall 2019 was 22%. A total of 5% of the First-time Full-time certificate and degree-seeking students transferred to other institutions prior to completing their Bristol program. The Massachusetts 2-year Public institutions Graduation Rates for the Fall 2019 cohort was 20%. Please note, comparison data may be one year behind. The first-time, full-time certificate and degree-seeking student population represents 14.9% of the Fall 2019 incoming class at Bristol.
