Currently enrolled at a community college within the state of Massachusetts? If so, you might be eligible for our Simmons University Community College Excellence Scholarship (SUCCESS).

Program Criteria

Students can either complete the MassTransfer General Education Foundation (34 credits) OR complete the MassTransfer General Education Foundation with an associate's degree (60 credits). Students completing either of these pathways and earning a cumulative GPA of 3.0 (including all post-secondary institutions), will be eligible to apply for our Transfer SUCCESS program.
